



RSS Instructions

Have you noticed this orange icon in the upper right corner of the website?



It is a symbol for RSS (Really Simple Syndication). RSS is a way for you to keep track of changes or additions to content on a website.

We hope that you will take advantage of this feature added to www.christianscienceneworleans.org We will NOT be bombarding you with frequent updates since this RSS feed will only be used to announce substantive changes to the website and to announce local events in the Christian Science community, such as an upcoming lecture.

Follow these steps to subscribe to this service:

- 1) Click on the orange cube at the top of the website home page.*
- 2) If you are using Windows, it will take you to a screen where you will click "subscribe to this feed."*
- 3) If you are using Apple, it will take you to a screen where you will click on "subscribe in mail" which is located in the lower right column.*
- 4) You should see a list of current feeds from our website, such as an upcoming Lecture Announcement or Open Bible.*
- 5) If you right click on the RSS feed (located in the left column on Apple computers), you will have some customized options. You may rename the feed (such as the shorter CSGNO) or show the feed in your mail inbox.*
- 6) When you click on "read more" under the feed notification, you will be brought to the website page with that new information.*

NOTE: To receive the RSS feed on your iPhone, ITouch, or iPad, it may be necessary to download a "Free RSS Reader" if you do not already have a reader installed on your mobile device. To get a RSS Reader, click on the App Store and search for "Free RSS Reader." MacReaders also work.
